## HIGHWAY WORK ZONE SAFETY ON TRIBAL LANDS

### Announcing a New On Line Training Course

U.S. Department of Labor/OSHA and the National Indian Justice Center will, pursuant to the grant from OSHA Susan Harwood Grants Program, produce a **self-paced, online training course** that will help tribal leaders (employers) and tribal transportation personnel (employees) develop a competency in OSHA and state standards and requirements and be better able to recognize hazards and integrate Work Zone Safety considerations in planning, managing and field operation of roadway/highway construction projects on or near tribal lands. The course contains a pre-test survey and a post –test survey in order to determine if the curriculum had the intended impact of increasing your knowledge and understanding of the course topics.

The course plan has been completed and approved by the U.S. Department of Labor/OSHA. The course is **free** and expected to take 8 hours to finish over a 2 week period.
