Tools for Implementing Tribal Sovereignty

The National Indian Justice Center (NIJC) assists tribes throughout Indian Country in drafting and revising tribal constitutions, codes and regulations. NIJC has assembled model codes on a range of subjects, from housing to civil jurisdiction. The objective of this session is to provide tribal leaders, judges, attorneys and staff responsible for drafting tribal laws with the tools to increase their capacity for self-governance, enhance the efficient operation of tribal government, assure tribal members that their tribal government is responsive and fair, and simplify tribal legislative and judicial systems. Time will be allocated to address your specific problems and priorities. We recommend that you bring copies of your code provisions with you. Participants will receive a comprehensive training manual and a certificate of achievement.
