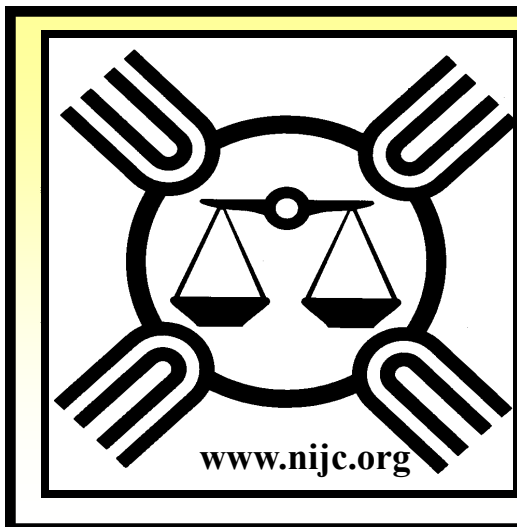

Self-Determination Through Improved Tribal Courts!

This training session is designed for Tribes who are developing new tribal courts and for those administering existing tribal courts. This session provides the information and skills development necessary to conduct an internal evaluation of a tribal court system and an analysis of what a court system needs to administer fair and equal justice in Indian country. We will analyze the purpose and function of a tribal court, baseline standards of measurement, the efficiency of operation, resolution of employee disputes and enforcement of ethical requirements. Participants will receive a comprehensive training manual and a certificate of achievement.
